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## Drug Screening Policy

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This policy is to insure the quality and safety of the Dunlap Fire Department members and the public in which it serves.

All new candidates are required to participate in a drug screening test after the completion of their 4<sup>th</sup> Drill. The fire department's physician will administer the test at the department expense. If a candidate prefers another doctor, they will incur the expense. After the completion of the 6<sup>th</sup> Drill and a negative test results, candidates will be issued fire gear, pager, and become a member of the Dunlap Fire Department with Tyro status.

Only negative results will be accepted. Inconclusive or diluted result will require the retake of drug screening at the candidate's own expense. Positive test will result in a six month waiting period before eligibility to retest at applicant's expense and they may reapply for candidacy. Positive test due to doctor prescribed medication will be viewed per case by the District Fire Chief.
